COURAGE

CPAF answered 3,703 calls on its 24-hour domestic violence and sexual assault hotline in 25 different languages.

"If someone is suffering because of domestic violence, I want to tell them not to wait, be brave, knock on CPAF's doors, and ask for help."

SUPPORT

121 survivors received services through CPAF's community-based case management and counseling program

LOVE

117 survivors and children received 7,295 nights of emergency shelter

31 survivors and children received transitional program services; 100% maintained or increased their income, and 80% moved into safe and permanent housing after graduating from the program.

BUILDING HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS

CPAF expanded violence prevention programming to include a community mobilization project in Long Beach (partnering with Khmer Girls in Action) and youth engagement with three Asian and Pacific Islander youth organizations (Educated Men with Meaningful Messages, Orange County Asian and Pacific Islander Alliance, and Project MotiVATE). In July, CPAF hosted our inaugural "Violence-Free Begins With Me" Youth Forum, gathering more than 50 youth and youth leaders to talk about preventing relationship violence in their communities.



BUILDING RESOURCES

To build resources for immigrant survivors of domestic and sexual violence, CPAF partnered with numerous organizations, including East West Bank, the Vedanta Society, Circle of Change Giving Circle, and more, to provide move-out and rental assistance to survivors and their families.



Project by Project (PbP) Los Angeles celebrated its 13th annual Plate by Plate event, raising \$25,000 for CPAF's programs. The volunteer organization's mission is to develop leaders through innovative philanthropy. PbP's 2015 campaign theme was affordable

housing and providing shelter to those in need. CPAF was selected as the LA chapter's beneficiary partner.

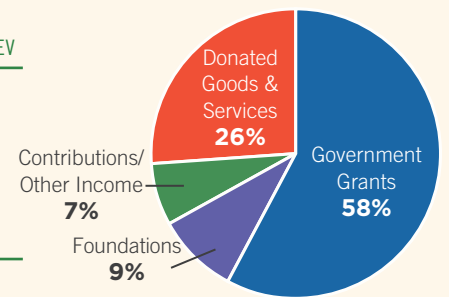
BUILDING COMMUNITY LEADERS

CPAF created a South Bay Advisory Council to support the operations of CPAF's transitional shelter and help expand CPAF's presence in South Bay. Council members include longtime volunteers, community supporters, and survivors who have graduated from CPAF's programs. The council is currently raising money for wellness scholarships for families in the Transitional Housing Program.

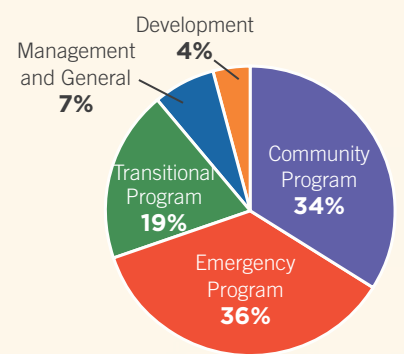
