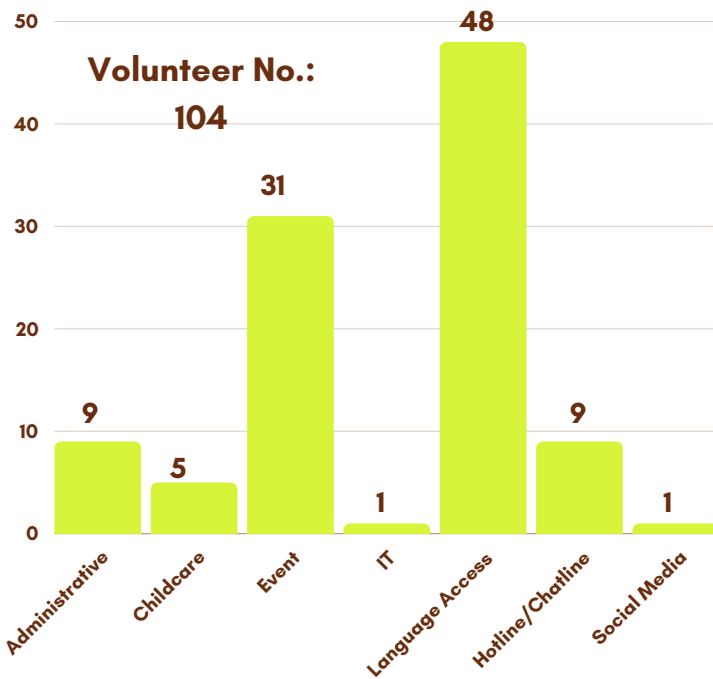

# VIP Program Snapshots & Goals

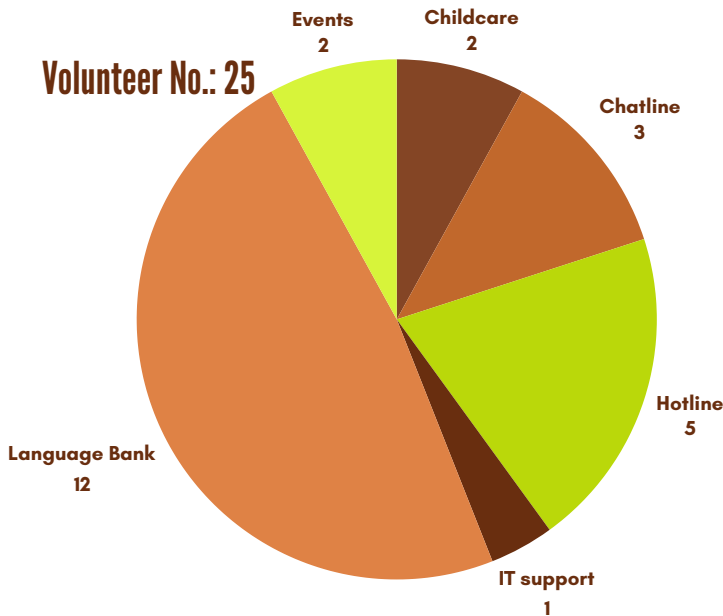
## Volunteer No. for 2023
